KCC Preschool provides a fun, loving, Christ-centered learning atmosphere where children are encouraged to grow socially, emotionally, creatively, mentally, and physically. Our goal is to help children adjust to the social classroom environment as they discover the joy of learning!

KCC Preschool Classes Will Meet as Follows:

The **3's & 4's** class meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9-11:30am. Your child must be potty trained and 3 years old by August 1st.

The **Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K)** class meets on Tuesdays & Thursdays from 12:30-3pm and on Wednesdays from 9am-1pm. Your child must be 4 years old by August 1st.

The Pre-K students get to bring their lunch to school on Wednesdays!

Classes will begin the Tuesday after Labor Day and will end in mid-May.

We will follow Clinton Central School Corporation's calendar in regards to vacations, as well as cancellations or delays due to weather. For cancellations or delays you can check the local news on Channel 13 and radio stations, or you may also go to Clinton Central's website (clintoncentral.org) and look under the "school status" link to see if there is a delay or cancellation. If Clinton Central has a 2 hour delay we will delay 1 hour. If there is a delay on a Tuesday or Thursday the morning class will meet from 10-11:30 & the afternoon class will not be affected. If there is a delay on Wednesday we will meet from 10:00-1:00.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition must be paid the first preschool day of each month. Checks should be made payable to Kirklin Christian Church. Cash is acceptable but must be placed in an envelope with the child's name on it. The monthly fee remains the same regardless of holidays or other breaks that may fall within the month.

The cost for the 3 & 4 year old class is \$70 per month.

The cost for the Pre-K class is \$85 per month.

A non-refundable \$25 registration fee is required upon enrollment. Also, a one-time \$30 activity fee which will be used to pay for snacks, crafts supplies, parties & field trips. Your child only needs to bring a backpack for preschool. All other supplies will be furnished, including: crayons, crayon box, glue sticks, scissors, and pencils.

Field Trips & Special Visitors

Field trips and special visitors will be planned throughout the school year. Parents are asked to sign and turn in the permission slip for their child's participation in these trips. Children are transported by parent volunteers who are licensed, experienced drivers in vehicles equipped with seat belts. Field trips will be planned during regular school hours unless otherwise notified. Because these trips are planned throughout the school year, we will let you know as soon as we have them planned out. All parents are invited and encouraged to go with us!

Snacks, Parties and Birthdays

A \$30 activity fee (which was mentioned above) will go towards snacks and drinks for the entire school year. This money also pays for anything we would need for our holiday parties (e.g. treat bags, snacks, party supplies, etc.) If you want to send a special snack for your child's birthday you are welcome to do so. We just ask that you notify us in advance so that we can avoid having two snacks planned for the same day.

Miscellaneous

Children are asked to wear comfortable play clothes (we sometimes get very messy!) Your child is to bring a backpack to school daily for take home papers. We ask that you include an extra change of clothes which will remain in their backpack in case of an accident or spill. At the start of the school year we will provide a special folder for the students. This folder serves as our line of parent/teacher communication. All papers will be sent home in these folders and the monthly tuition payment is to be placed in the folder as well.

Curriculum

Our preschool's curriculum is carefully planned. Our program offers enough repetition to make children comfortable and confident without being monotonous. Children are praised, encouraged, loved & nurtured.

The following activities are offered most every day; art, calendar time, story time, songs/music, finger plays, prayer before snack and lunch, exercise, games, free play, and review of the day. We will also focus on shapes, colors, numbers, alphabet, phonics, health & safety, directions, beginning math concepts, phone number & address recognition/memorization, weather patterns, seasons, and recognizing & printing their names. Individual assessments will be administered throughout the school year to track each child's progress.
